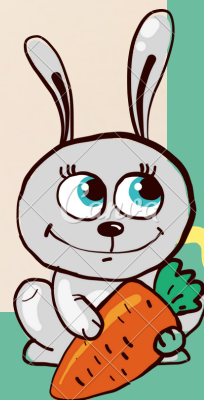

Women celebrate this day all over the world.

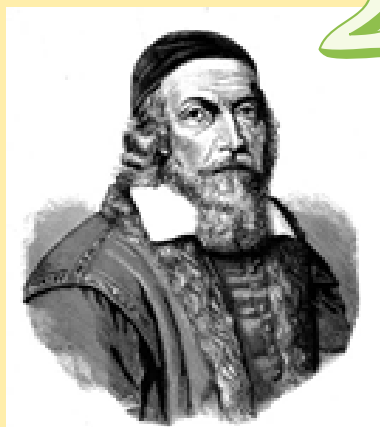


My love is in my heart.

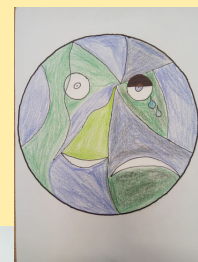




# THE DAY OF THE EARTH

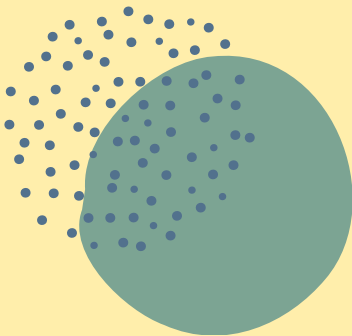
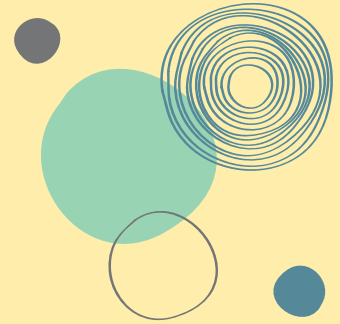
